**Awarding Contract for Concrete Work at the Courthouse

- 1 **WHEREAS**, the 2015 budget included funds to replace the service drive that leads to the dumpsters off
- 2 of Saint Lawrence Street at the Courthouse; and

- 4 **WHEREAS**, funds were also budgeted to replace the sidewalks on the northwest side of the Community
- 5 Corrections Building; and

- 7 **WHEREAS**, in addition to the base bid on the sidewalks, an alternate bid was requested to install drain
- 8 tile to collect water from downspouts so that it doesn't pond and freeze on the sidewalks; and

- 10 **WHEREAS**, specifications were prepared and bids solicited for the work.

- 12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled
- 13 this 8th day of October, 2015, that a contract to replace the service drive at the
- 14 Courthouse in the base bid amount of \$17,740.00, and the sidewalks at the Community Corrections
- 15 Building, in the amount of \$8,319.00 plus the alternate of \$1,535.00, be awarded to Anglin LLC of
- 16 Monroe, WI; and

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FISCAL NOTE:





Executive Summary

Concrete Service Drive and Sidewalk Replacement

The resolution before you awards a contract for replacement of the concrete service drive that leads to the dumpster area at the Courthouse off of St Lawrence Street. The resolution also authorizes replacement of 155 lineal feet of sidewalk at the Community Corrections Building, and the installation of drain tile to collect the water from downspouts that in the past ran across the sidewalk and froze, creating a slipping hazard. The drive and the sidewalks have deteriorated beyond repair.

The work is currently scheduled for the second week in October.
