# APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF PARTS FOR REPAIR TO AIRPORT EQUIPMENT AND AMENDING THE SOUTHERN WISCONSIN REGIONAL AIRPORT BOARD BUDGET

- 1 WHEREAS, Rock County owns an airport known as the Southern Wisconsin Regional
- 2 Airport; and,

- 4 WHEREAS, in April 2011 the airport took delivery of a 2011 SnoGo blower unit purchased
- 5 from Wausau Equipment Company in conjunction with a 2010 Caterpillar Wheel Loader and
- 6 bucket at a contract cost of \$384,350; and

- 8 WHEREAS, this piece of equipment is critical to the airport's efficient snow removal
- 9 operation as required by the Airport's FAA approved Snow and Ice Control Plan; and,
- 11 WHEREAS, on February 12, 2021 the SnoGo blower attachment became inoperable due to
- 12 the failure of the lower gear box assembly. Wausau Equipment Company, Inc. is the
- 13 manufacturer of this equipment and has provided a statement that they are the sole provider of
- 14 the parts needed to repair it. Parts for this repair have been quoted at a cost of \$31,696.08, and
- 15 airport staff will perform the repair; and,

- WHEREAS, a contingency fund of \$500 is requested to cover freight and other possible incidental expenses related to the repair of the snow blower.

- 20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors
- duly assembled this <u>35th</u> day of <u>Mauch</u>, 2021, does hereby approve a purchase order to Wausau Equipment Company in the amount of \$31,696.08 for the parts
- 23 needed to repair the Airport's 2011 SnoGo snow blower unit and a contingency fund of
- 24 \$500 be added to the airport's Machinery and Equipment Parts account for shipping and
- 25 incidental expenses.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF PARTS FOR REPAIR TO AIRPORT EQUIPMENT AND AMENDING THE SOUTHERN WISCONSIN REGIONAL AIRPORT BOARD BUDGET

In 2011 the airport took delivery of a 2010 Caterpillar Loader with a 2011 SnoGo blower attachment at a contract cost of \$384,350. This piece of equipment is critical to the Airport's snow removal process and is used to blow piles of plowed snow off the pavement and out of Airport's movement and non-movement areas.

On February 12, 2021 during snow removal operations the lower gear box assembly became inoperable and caused a catastrophic failure of the machine. Wausau Equipment Company, Inc. located in New Berlin is the manufacturer of this piece of equipment and based on the letter dated February 25, 2021 from Christine Shepherd, Customer Service Manager for Wausau Equipment Company, Inc., is the sole provider of parts that can be used to repair it. The quote for the parts for this repair is \$31,696.08 and does not include freight.

Shipping costs are unknown at this time and the airport is requesting an additional \$500 in contingency to go towards shipping costs and any other incidental expenses incurred during the repair of this equipment. Airport staff can perform the repair saving the cost of labor.
