1 **WHEREAS**, Ilah Hartung has served the citizens of Rock County for over seventeen (17) years as a
2 dedicated and valued employee of Rock County; and,

5 Hartung worked in multiple capacities there, one of which was as a Juvenile Restitution Coordinator.
6 In this role, she helped people pay back their victims by assisting them to find employment. Ms.
7 Hartung also worked with youth in finding them volunteer opportunities by searching out local
8 agencies willing to allow kids to complete their community service hours. In addition, Ms. Hartung
9 worked with the Children's Community Support Network as a Service Coordinator. Ms. Hartung
10 promoted the mission of *keeping kids in the home, out of jail, and in school* by working with families
11 to create service plans which focused on attaining their family goals. In January 2009, Ms. Hartung
12 transferred to the Long Term Support Division to support frail elderly and physically disabled adults in
13 the community who were on the COP and Waiver programs. Ms. Hartung coordinated services such
14 as: supportive homecare, meals, lawn/snow removal, medical supplies, and a variety of other needed
15 services. Ms. Hartung was also the Lead Case Manager for the Alzheimer's Family Caregiver Support
16 Program (AFCSP.) As the lead AFCSP worker, Ms. Hartung worked with individuals and their family
17 members who have been afflicted with a dementia diagnosis. She provided resources to these families
18 and authorized payments to support victims of dementia and their caregivers. Ms. Hartung advocated
19 and worked on behalf of her clients; always searching for services and offering a helping hand. Ms.
20 Hartung will be retiring from Rock County Department of Human Services on August 3, 2012; and,
