REQUESTING THE BOARD OF HEALTH TO INVESTIGATE OPTIONS FOR DENTAL SERVICES FOR LOW-INCOME RESIDENTS OF ROCK COUNTY AND REPORT TO THE COUNTY BOARD

- 1 WHEREAS, dental care services are needed for the uninsured and underinsured low-income
2 residents of Rock County; and
3
4 WHEREAS, poor oral care can lead to many other health related problems; and
5
6 WHEREAS, budget constraints are difficult but the needs for the uninsured and underinsured
7 low-income residents of Rock County are even greater; and
8
9 WHEREAS, the Board of Health acts as a liaison for community health planning.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly
12 assembled this 15th day of December, 2016 that they request the Board of Health to do the following:
13
14 1) Gather information on existing County programs in Wisconsin that are helping those residents
15 that are at or below 200% of the federal poverty line obtain appropriate dental care.

17 2) Review and develop dental strategies that have effective cost containment to assist local
18 residents to obtain dental care.
19
20 3) Create a plan to assist low-income residents of Rock County in obtaining dental services
21 including partnering with local agencies such as Blackhawk Technical College.
22
23 4) Develop a committee of community leaders to come up with strategies to help provide dental
24 services to low-income County residents.
25
26 5) Lobby the state legislature to improve reimbursement rates to providers offering dental
27 services to low-income County residents and ask that Rock County be included in the State dental pilot
28 program.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Health shall report back their findings and
31 proposed plan to the County Board at the February 23, 2017 County Board meeting.


