- B. Arrive at 9:45 am. Atkinson Farms - Sinkhole Abandonment.** Section 28, LaPrairie. A sinkhole will be abandoned while we're on site. Norm Tadt and Tom Sweeney will discuss Groundwater Quality issues. **Depart at 10:30 am. - 45 min.**
- C. Arrive at 10:40 am. County Materials – Non-Metallic Mining Reclamation.** Sections 6, Turtle. Observe a Nontraditional Non Metallic Mining Site Reclamation effort. Chris Murphy. **Depart at 11:10 am. - 30 min.**
- D. Arrive at 11:25 pm. Animal Waste Storage Ordinance and Farmland Preservation Program.** Section 30, Bradford. A new animal facility is under construction which will integrate a manure storage under roof. Norm Tadt.
