

**COUNCIL ON AGING NUTRITION PROGRAM ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES**

**Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements:** Rane Goodroad distributed the dining center visit sign-up sheet and a handout of congregate dining center expectations and guidelines.

Joyce Lubben stated that the composition of the Advisory Board will remain the same for 2017 as everyone whose terms are expiring are eligible and willing to serve a second term.
