This day surveyed by direction of the supervisors of the Town of Johnstown the following described road to wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 16; thence running South 8° East 20 chains to a stake; thence South 33° and 49' East 17 chains to a stake; thence South 13° East 15 chains to a stake; thence South 30° 30' West 12 chains and 30 links to a stake; thence South 8° East 20 chains to a stake. The said courses and distances are the center of the road variation of the magnetic needle 8° East.
