Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Johnstown in said county and six freeholders residing in the Town of Harmony in said County of Rock for the altering of a certain highway on the line between the Towns of Johnstown and Harmony from being rods wide as originally laid out to the width of three rods. The center of said highway to be on the line between Section 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 of the Town of Harmony and Sections 6, 7, 18, 19 30 and 31 of the Town of Johnstown and the width of said highway to be one and one-half rods in the Town of Harmony and one and one-half rods in the Town of Johnstown through the entire length thereof.

We the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 7th day of February 1884 make out and sign a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 21st day of February 1884 at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day at the house of William Mingies it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice. And having first been satisfied by due proof that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands in each town through which said highway passes by serving each of them personally with such notice on or by copy thereof, left with or or at the usual place of abode of each occupant of said lands and had also been posted up in three public places in each of said towns ten days before the time of our said meeting. We the undersigned a majority of the supervisors of each of said towns acting together did proceed to examine personally such highway and having heard all reasons which were offered for and against the altering of the same did so acting together decide upon such application and deeming it necessary did then and there determine to alter said highway as hereinafter described we then announced said determination to interested parties who were present objection having been made by one of said parties that our action was illegal for the reason that one of the supervisors of the Town of Johnstown residing on the line of said highway and that he was therefor interested we then and there reconsidered our action. The said meeting was then duly adjourned by us to the 26th day of February
