Survey of the center line of a Highway made this
27th day of March 1866.

Commencing at a point in the center of the highway running North and South through the center of the town of Avon and 80 rods North of the South West corner of Section 22 Town 1 Range 10 of said town. Thence East four hundred and ninety six rods and 23 links passing through Section 22 and part of Section 20 and through lands owned by Wm. Yost, L. T. Chase, L. Flint, -Emery, and lands owned by the Beloit Academy and W. Bullis, and C. Kelly: thence South 70°, East fifty three rods to the North West corner of the N.E.¼ of the N.E.¼ of Section 26 through lands the owner of which is unknown: thence South one hundred and sixty rods through Section 26 passing through lands owned by John Stokes, E. Clinton and E. Parkhurst., Thence South 82½° East 78 Rods through Section 26 owner of land unknown: thence South 57½° East 46 rods through Section 26 owner of land unknown: thence South 43° East 92 rods through Section 26 and through the corner of the S.W. ¼ of S.W.¼ of Sec. 25 to the North line of Section 36 Town 1 Range 10 owner of land unknown thence due East to the town line between the towns of Avon and Newark.
