At a meeting of the Supervisors of the town of Newark and Avon in said County of Rock held in said town of Newark on this 28th day of February A.D. 1855 for the purpose of laying out a highway upon the line between the said towns. It is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors that a highway be laid out on the line between the said towns: Beginning at the North West corner Section 6 in the town of Newark and running thence South on the said Section 6 said highway to be of the width of four rods and the said section and town line to be the center of said highway and it is further ordered that that portion of the said highway commencing at the North End of said road and running 160 rods South be made and kept in repairs by the town of Newark and the remainder of said road shall be made and kept in repairs by the town of Avon.
