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At a meeting of the Supervisors of the town of Avon all the Supervisors being notified met pursuant to notice on the 30th day of November 1857 to act on the above notice. It is ordered and determined by the above Supervisors that a highway be laid out in the town of Avon Rock County, State of Wisconsin as follows: Commencing on the town line between Section 32 and 33 thence running North on the Section line two miles, to the South East corner of Section 20: thence West on the Section line twenty chains thence North on the quarter quarter line forty chains to the North West corner of the North West quarter of the South East quarter of said Section 20 thence North 10 degrees West six chains and thirty eight links thence North twenty nine degrees West six chains thence North thirty three degrees East 7 chains and twenty five links intersecting the highway on the North East side of Sugar River variation of the Magnitic needle six degrees East. The within described road to be four rods wide.
