Why The Bus?

ECONOMIC

- Public transportation is a \$55 billion industry that employs more than 400,000 people
- An individual can achieve an average annual savings of more than \$9,900 by taking public transportation instead of driving

ENVIRONMENTAL

- Public transportation saves 37 million metric tons of carbon dioxide annually
- A switch from a 20-mile roundtrip commute to public transportation decreases annual CO2 emissions by 4,800 pounds per year

ENERGY

- Public transportation saves the U.S. the equivalent of 4.2 billion gallons of gasoline annually
- Public transportation use saves the equivalent of 900,000 automobile fill-ups every day
