

## **Lee County Park:**



This beautiful, wooded, 40 acre park was originally bought by the Town of Clinton from the Lee family. The township donated the park to Rock County in 1966.

Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Newhouse donated an additional tenth of an acre in 1975 for a driveway on the north end of the park, so visitors could enter and leave from both sides.

## **Trail System:**

The hiking and nature trail run through the extensive wooded area of the park, which serves as habitat for a variety of wildlife.

The trail continues around a prairie planting on the north side of the park and then across the gravel park road into the arboretum. The arboretum was



planned and planted in 1968 by the Springbrook Watershed Group. It has grown into a mature forest. The prairie was started in 1987 and additional native wildflowers and grasses have been added throughout the years through a collaborative effort of 4-H groups and the Parks Department.



## **Softball Diamond:**

The softball diamond is located in the northern portion of the park. The 4-H group from Clinton and Turtle, constructed, to a great extent, the diamond. They furnished volunteer labor and materials. The diamond is rented through the Rock County Parks Department.



## **Pavilion:**



Host your family reunion, graduation party, wedding, or picnic here. The shelter is rented through the Rock County Parks Department. If the shelter is not reserved, it is available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Rentals always take precedent over drop-in users.

The shelter was erected in 1976 as a joint effort between Rock County and the Clinton Township. Rock County provided materials for the shelter and the citizens of Clinton generously donated 100 man hours plus the use of heavy equipment toward this project.

## **Location:**

Lee County Park is located south of Clinton at the junction of State Hwy 140 and State Hwy 67.

## **Amenities:**

Include picnic tables, grills, drinking water, and restroom facilities. In an effort to keep the area clean, dumpsters are provided.
